



Forton Primary School – Class 2 Curriculum Overview

In **Art & design** we will be drawing, painting and using clay to develop skills with different media and evaluating our own work.

In **English** we will be looking at stories written by Julia Donaldson, retelling familiar stories and innovating our own story based on a Julia Donaldson book. Linked to our topic we will also be looking at non-chronological reports, reading information leaflets, books and posters and creating our own.

In **Maths** we will be covering the following topics: number and place value, addition and subtraction and measure.

VOCABULARY

Tens, ones, addition, subtraction, equal, length, height, weight, centimetres, meters, millilitres.

In **Geography** we will be locating hot and cold parts of the World, naming the World's continents and oceans as well as using a variety of maps and identifying features. We will also be identifying local weather patterns throughout the year.

VOCABULARY

Characters, setting, story map, heading, subheading, caption, contents page, facts.

In **Science** we will be looking at animals, we will sort, compare and classify different animals, research using information books and ICT to answer questions about animals working to be able to identify and name common animals and know what features they have.

Possible questions-

How is the weather different at the equator and poles to our country?
What sort of animals live in that hot/cold place?

This term, Class 2's topic is 'Amazing animals'

Possible questions-

How do we know they are animals?
Are all animals the same?

VOCABULARY

Land, sea, ocean, season, weather, city, town, village.

In Religious Education we will be learning about Christianity. We will focus on why Christians believe in God 'the father' and why Jesus is special to them.

VOCABULARY

Head, leg, body, wing, senses, paws, claws, fly, swim, crawl, climb, fur, scales, camouflage, mammal, bird, fish, amphibian, reptile.

In **PE** we will be working on our ball skills as well as learning and creating simple dance routines. PE days will be – Thursday & Friday.

VOCABULARY

Aim, accuracy, space, pass, ball, throw, catch, kick, routine, counting, rhythm.
