



Forton Primary School – Class 2 Curriculum Overview

In **Science** we will be learning about animals and their habitats. We will also be investigating what animals need to grow and survive.

VOCABULARY

Habitat, food, alive, food chain, growth, dead, never been alive, micro-habitats, woodland, ocean, rainforest, seashore.

In **English** we will be writing adventure stories, letters and classic poems. We will also be learning how to use adjectives, suffixes, subordination for time and adverbs correctly in our writing.

VOCABULARY

Sequence, discuss, syllables, subordination, suffix, proofread, inference, apostrophes, past tense, questions, adjectives, verbs, statement, command, exclamation.

This term, Class 2's topic is based on the novel 'Wind in the Willows'.

In **Geography** we will be learning to name, locate and identify characteristics of the four countries and capital cities of the United Kingdom. We will be investigating seasonal and daily weather patterns in the United Kingdom, whilst using maps to locate different places.

VOCABULARY

City, town, village, map, globe, locate, buildings, roads, fields, land, sea, weather, seasons, spring, summer, autumn, winter.

In **Religious Education** we will be learning about Islam. We will focus on daily routines and religious artefacts.

VOCABULARY

Expression, faith, prayer, Mosque, routine.

In **Maths** we will be covering the following topics: time, statistics, addition and subtraction, measurement, fractions, position and direction and shape. We will also focus on developing our reasoning skills.

VOCABULARY

Clock face, earlier, later, hours, minutes, seconds, more, less, place value, tens, ones, add, subtraction, total, capacity, order, compare, volume, temperature, numerator, denominator, quarter, half, three-quarter, properties, symmetry.

In **Design and Technology**, we will be designing, making and evaluating a product made from fabric. We will focus on developing cutting and joining skills.

VOCABULARY

Join, fabric, stitch, glue, staples, sewing, tape, buttons, beads, braids, ribbons, printing, painting, product, design, make, evaluate.

In **Computing** we will be learning about keeping safe when using a computer or iPad.

VOCABULARY

Technology, safely, respectfully, personal information, permission, safe, internet.

In **Art and Design**, we will be continuing to develop our observational drawing skills.

VOCABULARY

Pencils, rubbers, crayons, pastels, charcoal, ballpoints, chalk, tone, line, patterns, watercolour, ready mix paint.

In **PE** we will be attending swimming lessons and developing our attacking and defending strategies in games.

VOCABULARY

Invasion, games, aim, accuracy, space, pass, ball, opponents, throw, catch, run.
